CAMPGROUND SERVICES

AMENITTES

A number of amenities are provided in each campground including, hydration stations, phone charging units, undercover seating areas, food and beverage outlets, showers and toilets, including accessible toilets at each campground. An accessible shower is located at Highside South campground. Showers and toilets will be cleaned each night.

FIRST AID

First Aid services are located in both Campgrounds alongside the Campground Customer Service Offices. First Aid assistance is available 24 hours per day in the Campground Customer Service Offices.

FOOD/DRINK

The Champions Café, located within the Visitor Centre, will be open from Thursday serving breakfast, lunch and dinner. Take away food, ice and alcohol are also available in both Campgrounds.

GENERATORS

Generators are permitted, but must not be operational between 10pm and 7am, and an adult must be in attendance at all times the generator is in use. Fuel for generators must be properly stored and not in tents or structures. Re-fuelling is only permitted whilst the generator is turned off.

RUBBISH

To assist in keeping the Campgrounds as clean as possible, you will be issued with two rubbish bags (clear bag is for all recycling – cans, paper, plastic drink bottles etc). Please leave all full rubbish bags at the designated waste disposal points by 10am each morning for collection. Replacement bags will be available from the Campground Customer Service Offices. Please do not move wheelie bins, as trucks have limited access on roads through the Campgrounds, and collection may not be possible.

SHUTTI E SERVICE

A shuttle bus service for campers heading to and from Cowes will pick up and drop off from the Visitor Centre Car Park. This service will be available to campers from 6pm-12am Friday-Sunday. More information can be found here: https://www.southcoastbus.com.au/timetable/.

CAMPGROUND

The Campground Customer Service Offices will be in operation from 9am Thursday 16th October and close 12pm Monday 20th October. There are 2 offices: one located in Trackside Campground and another located in Highside South Campground.


FIRES

- Barbeques and campfires are permitted for cooking, warmth and comfort.
- Campfires must only be lit in either a container or in a trench no greater than 30cm deep, and must be kept at a reasonable and manageable size.
- The ground and airspace within three metres of a fire must always be clear (including fence lines).
- An adult must be in attendance at all times the fire is alight.
- Fires and candles are not to be lit within tents or structures.
- Should any fires become dangerous, take immediate action to extinguish the fire. Remove all persons to a safe distance and immediately contact Campground Management.
- All campers must immediately obey a reasonable request from Security to extinguish their campfire.
- Firewood is available for purchase at \$20 per bag, and kindling at \$10 per bag, from the Campgrounds Customer Service Office.
- Any firewood brought in, must be pre-split and less than 50cm in length.

PERSONAL SAFETY

Please do not climb on any structures and beware of slippery ground conditions.

VEHICLES

All vehicles are subject to security checks upon entry to the Campgrounds for prohibited items.

All unregistered vehicles are STRICTLY prohibited. These include minibikes, monkey bikes, electric scooters, etc. Bicycles are also prohibited from being ridden within and between campgrounds. Please be advised that vehicles cannot be used for transport within and between Campgrounds, and all vehicles are STRICTLY prohibited on the Go-Kart Track in Trackside Campground at ALL TIMES except at the marked designated track crossing locations. Patrons who drive/ride on the Go-Kart Track will be immediately evicted from the Campground and Event and may be charged for any damage caused to the Go-Kart Track.

ALCOHO

As per Conditions of Entry to Campgrounds, alcohol not purchased within the venue is prohibited in the Campgrounds. Alcohol brought in will be confiscated by Security and NOT returned.

SECURITY

Please ensure all personal valuable items are kept in a safe place. No responsibility will be taken for lost or damaged personal property.

WEATHER

Phillip Island can experience extreme weather conditions; weather warnings will be posted on Campground Notice Boards. In case of severe rain and wind, please ensure all loose materials are secure.

PLEASE NOTE


